

Cambridge Crossways Summer Club 2010

Here's some information about how the summer club works:

<p>When, where, and how much?</p>	<p>The Perse School, Cambridge, each Tuesday evening during the summer, from 7.15pm → 10.15pm, from Tuesday 18th May to Tuesday 31st August. <i>[During this period, there may be a 2 week closure (to be advised by The Perse School).]</i></p> <p>Cost of membership is unchanged from last year, at £30.</p> <p>50% of any profits from the Summer Club will be donated to Sports Relief.</p>
<p>When can I join?</p>	<p>The club will be open for membership from 1st May, and closes to new members on 17th May. There will be a limit on the number of members, so "first come first served".</p>
<p>What's the ability level?</p>	<p>Club standard players only please.</p> <p>You will also need to be a Badminton England member.</p>
<p>How do I join?</p>	<p>Please send...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a cheque for £30 to "Cambridge Crossways B.C" • a completed membership form (downloadable from www.camways.co.uk/summer_club_application_form.pdf) • a 1st class stamped self-addressed envelope (for your shoe tag – see below) <p>... to: Paul Hilditch, 3 The Terrace, Hampden Gardens, Cambridge, CB1 3DU.</p>
<p>Can I turn up and try it out, before joining?</p>	<p>No, I'm afraid not. There will be no exceptions to this – if you turn up on the night and are not a member, you will need to join on the night (if it isn't already full).</p>
<p>How will it be identified that I have joined?</p>	<p>Upon joining the Summer Club, you will be given a shoe tag that you must wear when coming to the Summer Club.</p> <p>Without this shoe tag you will be refused entry.</p>
<p>Can juniors join?</p>	<p>Yes, but if you're under the age of 16, then you must be accompanied each evening by a parent / guardian.</p>
<p>Do I need to bring shuttles?</p>	<p>Yes, the club will <u>not</u> be providing shuttles – you must bring your own.</p>
<p>Setting up the courts?</p>	<p>You will be responsible for setting up the courts, and putting them away, including clearing away used shuttles. Nets and poles are available in the storage area (diagonally opposite the hall doorway).</p>
<p>Organising games?</p>	<p>The Summer Club will retain its informal nature and no physical pegboard will be used. However, please organise matches in the same spirit as a pegboard – those who have been waiting longest are first in line for a game when a court comes free.</p>
<p>Can I play with the same people all night?</p>	<p>The club is really about mixing in with others; but if you want to play all night in a foursome, then you will still need to come off court at the end of each game, and come back on when it's your turn.</p>
